

GENERAL MEETING MINUTES SEPTEMBER 27, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 by President, Terrie Sato.

- 1. Minutes from the 8/21/23 General Membership meeting were approved.
- **2. Report of the Board** The budget committee presented the 2024 budget. It was suggested that the club make a substantial donation again this year. The budget was voted on and approved.
- **3. Report of the President** Terrie- At the last meeting, Terrie asked for members to think about the challenges our Club faces. Getting volunteers was the biggest challenge mentioned, followed by building a sense of community. Several possible solutions were suggested, and there will be an opportunity to discuss this later in the meeting.
- **4. Report of the Treasurer** Sue presented an updated report. The report can be found in the "members only" section on the website.
- 5. **Report of the Secretary** Rhonda received acknowledgement from AKC for receipt of the application and judges slate for the spring obedience and rally trial.
- 6. Committee Reports
- a. **Membership-** Cathy Soule there were three second readings and the full members voted to approve new members Charlie Clarke, Lisa Witte, and Melissa Knapp.
- b. **Agility** the 2023 agility trial ended up making a profit. Linda Shea has agreed to chair the 2024 trial (with help). Linda and others will be working on forming a committee for the trial with the goal of 5 individuals.
- c. **Hearts and Flowers** Gloria a card was sent to Holly Krohn and the club sent a card to Gloria Newby.
- d. **Budget** The 2024 annual budget was reviewed and approved.
- e. **Spring trial 2024** Amanda March 30 & 31 -The judges are in place. The budget needs to be reviewed by the board and will be presented to the membership in November. Most of the committee is in place. The trial takes place on Easter weekend, which may affect entries. The members voted on and approved the amount of \$225 for trophies.

Rent-A-Ring and Ten Minute Tickers

November 11 from 9am to 1pm at Donida Farm

Kathy Lang Coaching is excited to be able to offer four-ring events at Donida Farm in Auburn, WA. Two Ten-Minute Ticker (aka Run Through) Rings and two Rent A Rings will be set up in the big dressage arena on the packed dirt floor. Ten Minute Ticker (TMT) slots will be 10 minutes long and a "judge" will be provided to assist you -- putting your through a class or helping you work on select exercises. The cost for 10 minutes is \$12.

AKC Obedience & Rally Judges October Board Meeting

from the AKC Companion Events Department

The minutes of the October Board Meeting have been published. https://www.akc.org/about/minutes -reports/board-minutes/

Here is a synopsis of items that affect our sports:

Catalog Class Order – Obedience: The Board VOTED to approve a Staff recommendation to modify Chapter 1, Section 3 of the Obedience Regulations to state that the Regular and Preferred Open and Utility class entries may be listed together in the catalog, the same as they are in the judging program and judge's book. The Board VOTED to adopt the recommendation effective January 1, 2024.

\$3.50 Recording/Service Fee for all Entries:

The Board reviewed a recommendation to adopt a consistent recording/service fee of \$3.50 per entry across all sports. Currently, all Performance Events are \$3.50 per entry, while Conformation and Companion Events are \$3.50 for the first entry and \$3.00 for all subsequent entries of a dog at the same event.

The change would result in consistency across all sports. Since July 1, 2013, all Performance Events have had a \$3.50 fee for every entry of a dog in the event. If the \$3.50 fee implemented in 2008 for Conformation was adjusted for inflation, it would be \$4.76 today. The Board VOTED (unanimously) to adopt the recommendation effective January 1, 2024.

Parent Club Request for Three-Quarter Jump Heights in Obedience:

Australian Terrier and Old English Sheepdog: The Australian Terrier Club of America (ATCA) and the Old English Sheepdog Club of America (OESDCA) have submitted documentation to support their request to have the jump height requirement in obedience for their breed to be lowered to three quarters the height of the dog at the withers.

The Board VOTED (unanimously) to approve the requests of the ATCA and the OESDCA to have the jump height requirement in Obedience for their breed to be lowered to three-quarters the height of the dog at the withers. This change will become effective January 1, 2024.

A Note on Rally Judging - Food and/or Elimination in the Ring

from the AKC Companion Events Department

If food is in the ring or the dog eliminates while in the ring for judging, the team will receive a nonqualifying score. If either of these issues occur during awards, the score is not changed from qualifying to non-qualifying.

At a recent event there was some confusion and a misunderstanding. This issue has been resolved.
